

***BLBA Summer Camp
Parent Letter,
June 25-30, 2023***



Dear Parents:

We are so excited you have decided to make camp part of your family's summer plans. Enclosed you should find all the necessary information to answer your questions and make preparing for camp a bit easier.

In addition to the packing list your camper has received it is important to note that all medications must be in original containers with labels intact. This includes prescription drugs as well as over the counter medications. It is vital that all medications are properly labeled with the child's name, name of drug, physician, dosage, etc. Please place each child's meds in a quart sized zip-lock bag with child's name written in marker on the outside of the plastic bag. All medications will be delivered to the Camp Nurse at check-in. Thank you so much for your cooperation in this area, as we want to provide our Camp Nurse with the most organized information possible so she may provide the best of care to your child.

Please provide a clean, plain white t-shirt for your child to make his/her camp keepsake shirt with logo on it during craft time. We also suggest sending a Sharpie or other marker to be used for the signing of shirts which campers of all ages love to take part in.

Jr. and Sr. High School have the opportunity to purchase soda, Gatorade, and snacks each day at our Snack Shack with items priced in the \$.25 – \$2.00 range, water bottles are \$.25-\$.50. (we are working on getting snack prices as low as we can) Youth will also have the option in the afternoons to make some special crafts during our afternoon recreation periods at no charge. Please note however, each teen is responsible for his/her own money at camp. If they wish they can keep their snack money in an envelope with their name on it, in the snack shack for safe keeping.

Children's Camp (grades 2-5) all snacks and crafts are provided so please do not send any additional money with them.

All phones, tablets, keys (if driving themselves to camp) or anything of this nature must be turned in at the start of camp.

Please plan to deliver your child to camp on Sunday, June 25 at 4:00 P.M. Dinner will be served to campers at approximately 6:00 P.M. Please plan to pick up campers and join them for a send off rally promptly at 2:00 P.M. on Friday, June 30. **Please do not come earlier than 1:45.**
